Ottawa Public Health (OPH) Immunization

As a parent, keeping your kids safe and healthy is your number one priority. All children attending school between ages 4 to 17 need to be immunized according to the Ontario Immunization schedule. Immunizations protect children from many serious diseases that are easily spread in schools.



Parents are required to report all immunizations done at the doctor's office to OPH. Under this *Act*, OPH has the authority to suspend students from school. Notification letters were sent in November to parents alerting them of missing documentation. **Suspensions for the first group will commence on February 24, 2020. Please ensure your child's immunizations are up to date and then contact OPH with to confirm.**

Application Period: Cross-Boundary Transfers

If you or someone you know wishes to register their child at a school other than their home school, they must submit an application for a cross-boundary between Mon. Feb. 3rd - Tues. Feb. 18th

PLEASE NOTE: First register your child at their home school, then you may submit your request for a transfer to the school you wish for them to attend. Requests submitted after this period will not be reviewed until June 2020.
